We the undersigned commissioners appointed by the Court of Pleas and Quarter Session of said County. Having been duly sworn proceeded, on the 4th day of January 1854, to divide and make partition between and among, James Beach & Wife Rebecca Henry J. Long & Wife Mary David Register & Wife Dorcas. James High & Wife Eliza Du Gald & Reaves & Wife Frances William J. Stanley & Wife Helen John Mears & Wife Sarah Jeremiah M. Benson & Wife Anna Jane. William E. Gore James M. M. Gore Pinkney Gore Calven L. Gore & Asa F. Gore, tenants in common of the Negro Property Descended to them as Children and heirs at Law of William Gore Deceased. Whereupon, we have made and do hereby make the following Appropriations among the respective Claimants in Severalty, that is to say, the lot No 1 is assigned and Appropriated to James High & Wife Eliza, in Severalty, Consisting of A Negro man by the name of Jim valued at Seven Hundred and Seventy five Dollars. to lot No 2 is assigned and Appropriated to Pinkney Gore in Severalty, Consisting of A Negro man by the name of Mon valued at eight hundred Dollars, to lot No 3 is assigned and Appropriated to David Register and Wife Dorcas, in Severalty, Consisting of A Negro boy by the name of Arch & woman by the name of Tamer valued at Seven hundred and fifty five Dollars. to lot No 4 is assigned and Appropriated to William E. Gore in Severalty, Consisting of A Negro boy by the name of Ned & woman by the name of Jane valued at Six hundred and fifty one Dollars

We further charge the more valuable dividend with such sums of money respectively to be paid to those of inferior value respectively, as will make an equitable division; that is to say.

The lot No 1. Appropriated to James High and Wife Eliza is to pay to the lot No 4. Appropriated to William E Gore the sum of forty five Dollars and 70/100. The lot No 2 Appropriated to Pinkney Gore is to pay to the lot No 4 Appropriated to William E. Gore. the sum of thirty two Dollars and 60/100. The lot No 2 Appropriated to Pinkney Gore is to pay to the lot No 5 Appropriated to James M. Gore the sum of thirty eight Dollars & 10/100. The lot No 3 Appropriated to David Register and Wife Dorcas is to pay to the lot No 5 Appropriated to James M. Gore the sum of twenty five Dollars & 70/100. The lot No 6 Appropriated to Asa F. Gore is to pay to the lot No 5 Appropriated to James M. Gore the sum of sixty five Dollars and 50/100. The lot No 6 Appropriated to Asa F. Gore is to pay to the lot No 10 Appropriated to John Mears and Wife Sarah the sum of fifty five Dollars and 20/100. The lot No 7 Appropriated to Dagald F. Peaves and Wife Francis. is to pay to the lot No 10. Appropriated to John Mears and Wife Sarah the sum of Two hundred and twenty Dollars & 70/100. The lot No 8 Appropriated to Calum H. Gore is to pay to the lot No 10 Appropriated to John Mears and Wife Sarah the sum of Three Dollars and 40/100. The lot No 13 Appropriated to Calum H. Gore is to pay to the lot No 11. Rebecca in Severalty, consisting of a Negro Woman by
the name of Milledy and Two Girls Hagar and Mary
valued at Seven hundred and twenty five Dollars. to
lot N^o 9 is Assigned and Appropriated to Jeremiah
Benson and Wife Anna Jane in Severalty, consisting of
a Negro Woman by the name of Sew and Two Girls
Lilly and Peggy valued at Seven hundred Dollars. to
lot N^o 10 is Assigned and Appropriated to John Means
and Wife Sarah in Severalty, consisting of a Negro Girl
by the name of Easter valued at Four hundred and fifty
Dollars. to lot N^o 11 is Assigned and Appropriated to
Henry S. Long and Wife Mary in Severalty, consisting
of a Negro Girl by the name of Harriett valued at
five hundred and fifty Dollars. to lot N^o 12 is Assigned
and Appropriated to William J. Stanley and Wife Helen in
Severalty, consisting of a Negro boy by the name of
Frank and a Girl by the name of Rose valued at
eight hundred and seventy five Dollars. to lot N^o 13
is Assigned and Appropriated to Calvin C. Gore in
Severalty, consisting of a Negro boy by the name of
Bob and a Girl by the name of Ruffa valued at eight
hundred Dollars

to lot No 9 appropriated to Jeremiah M. Benson and wife Anne
Jane the sum of Twenty nine Dollars and thirty cents
The lot No 12 Appropriated to William J. Stanley
and wife Helen is to pay to the lot No 8 Appropri-
ated to James Beach and wife Rebecca the sum of Four
Dollars and 50/100
