 Calhoun County in the Year of our Lord, one thousand Eight-hundred  
 and Fifty four, between Daniel B. Davis, and W. H. Davis, of the one part  
 and Stephen Peacock, <sup>for myself</sup> the administrator of the Estate of Ralphford  
 Peacock of the other part, all of the aforesaid County and State, Witnesseth  
 that the said D. B. Davis and W. H. Davis, for and in the Consideration  
 of the Sum of Twenty Six Thousand Dollars to him in and paid  
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed  
 and doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto the  
 said D. B. Davis and W. H. Davis, their heirs and assigns, all those  
 tracts or parcels of land, Situate lying and being in the County of  
 Originally Early, now Calhoun, known and distinguished in the plan  
 of the 4<sup>th</sup> District of said County, as Lots No 2, Three Thousand and twenty  
 and three Thousand and forty Eight, containing Two Thousand and  
 fifty acres More or less, To have and to hold said tracts or parcels  
 of land unto themselves, the said D. B. Davis and W. H. Davis their  
 heirs and assigns, together with all and singular the rights, Privileges  
 and appurtenances, thereof to the same in any Manner belonging  
 to them and their own proper use Benefit and behoof, forever in fee  
 Simple: And the said Stephen Peacock, the administrator of the  
 Estate of Ralphford Peacock Deceased for himself his Executors and  
 administrators, the said bargained premises, unto the said D. B. Davis  
 and W. H. Davis their heirs and assigns, will warrant and forever defend  
 the right and title thereof against themselves, and against the  
 claim of all other persons whatsoever holding or claiming under him  
 In Witness Whereof the said Stephen Peacock for himself and the  
 administrator of the Estate of Ralphford Peacock Deceased, hath hereunto  
 set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and year above written
