Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared JAMES R. BOLIN of Geneva County, Alabama, Slocomb, who is personally known to me and who after being duly sworn deposes and says as follows:

My name is James R. Bolin. I am 84 years old. I, James R. Bolin, state under oath I know the Ward family, James B. Ward and Elizabeth English Ward and all their children. They had eight (8) children borned to them. Their names are as follows: John Jackson Ward; Thomas Jefferson Ward; James Madison Ward; Benjamin Franklin Ward, Elizabeth Ward; Mary Ward; and Monroe Ward. I knew the Davis family well. James M. Davis married Mary Ward, daughter of James B and Elizabeth English Ward. James M. Davis and Mary Ward Davis raised a family of thirteen (13) children, their names are as follows: Julia Davis, Jonas Davis; James M. Davis; John G. Davis; Mallisa Davis; Reasy Davis; Allen Thomas Davis; Nicy Davis; Susan Davis; Betsy Davis; Carrie Davis; Joseph Davis; Jasper Davis. They lived four (4) miles from my father. I knew both families well. I know them from childhood up. Elizabeth English Ward was a full-blooded Creek Indian. The last years of her life she lived with her daughter Mary Ward Davis.

I, James R. Bolin, was there at James M and Mary Ward Davis' the day she died.

I am not related by blood or marriage to Elizabeth English Ward or any of her descendants. I am not related by blood or marriage to any of the DAVIS family.
