Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Thomas Henry Peel, of Geneva County, Slossom, Alabama, who is personally known to me and who after being duly sworn deposes and says as follows:

"My name is Thomas Henry Peel, I am 86 years old. I, Thomas Henry Peel, state under oath I knew Elizabeth English Ward, widow of James B. Ward, and her two sons, John Jackson and Monroe Ward and her daughter, Mary Ward, who married James M. Davis. Elizabeth English Ward lived with her daughter, Mary Ward Davis in her later years and died there. I know Elizabeth English Ward for several years and she was known by all to be a full blooded Creek Indian. James M. Davis was my nearest neighbor, lived only two miles away."

"I am not related by blood or marriage to Elizabeth English Ward or any of her descendants. I am not related by blood or marriage to any of the Davis family."
